New addition seeks to recreate demolished sections.

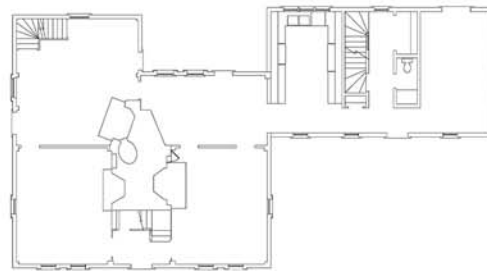
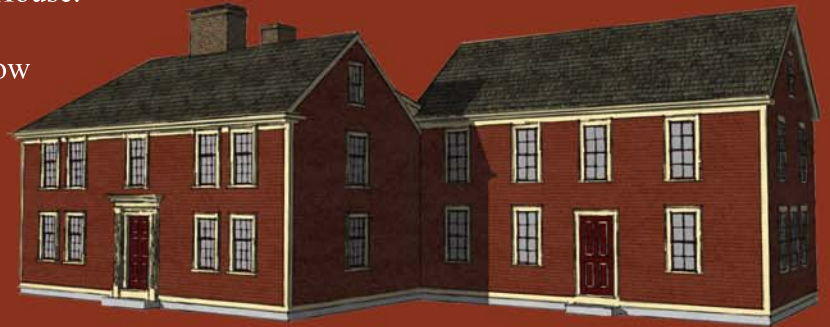
Work will be in compliance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Preservation.

Single family dwelling will make an attractive addition to the community, while saving history.

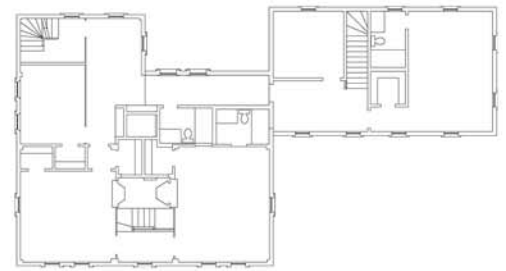
Rendering of the proposed relocated and renovated Clark House.
